

New CNS Opening Codes – WMS Migration 12.1



New CNS opening codes will be enabled to replace WMS codes that will become obsolete.

Alpha-numeric opening codes that begin with the letters “A”, “C”, “D” and “H” (except D92 and H83) will generate **CNS notices**. This will eliminate all of the noticing currently handled through MAP Automated Acceptance Noticing System protocol, as well as the need for many notices currently being prepared and manually mailed.

Note: Effective immediately, the MAP Automated Noticing System for case openings is being disabled. CNS support is being made available for all opening codes previously supported by this system except for **D92** (formerly 092) and **H83** (formerly 083). Until such time as CNS support for these opening codes may be added, cases opened for either of these two reasons will require the preparation and mailing of a **manual notice**.
